Our Answers to Seven Questions You May Have

1: Has anyone in our nursing home tested positive for COVID-19? *As of this publication, no. If someone at PRM would test positive, residents will be notified & their emergency contacts will be notified by phone message.*

2: What is PRM doing to prevent infections? Staff are screened every day they report to work & are wearing masks. Staff practice good hand washing & sanitize all surfaces multiple time easch day.

3: Does our staff have the Personal Protective Environment (PPE) like masks, face shields, gowns, gloves, that they need to stay safe & keep our patients safe? *Yes. We are continuing to obtain supplies according to our needs.*

4: What is PRM doing to help residents stay connected with their families & loved ones during this time? *Our staff helps residents connect through Face Time, Zoom & other apps, along with helping with cards & emails. (see front page)*

5: What is the plan for PRM to communicate important information to both residents & families on a regular basis? *Important timely information will be communicated via our phone message system to families & directly to residents.*

6: Is PRM currently at full staffing levels for nurses, aides & other workers? *Yes, we continue to meet or exceed required staffing levels.*

7: When can residents have visitors again? *Moving into the "Yellow Phase" of reopening PA does not include lifting visitor restrictions for nursing homes. Families will be notified by phone message when restrictions are modified or changed.*

Group Activities are currently ON HOLD until further notice. All are being adapted to conform with current Covid-19 directives.
