Tip Of the Month: Springtime Allergy Survival!

Springtime means longer days, warmer weather, blooming flowers and the return of pollen. Some tips to help minimize pollen allergy symptoms are:

- Know the pollen count
- Stay indoors & keep windows closed when pollen count is high
- Avoid being outside between 5 a.m. & 9 p.m. especially on windy days
- Take allergy medicine before going outside; wear a mask when doing yard work
- After coming indoors, change your clothing & take a shower
- Try over the counter antihistamines to treat symptoms such as runny nose, itchy eyes, congestion/cough
- Be aware that using nasal decongestants for more than 3 days causes a rebound effect.
