#### Covid Update

Pleasant Ridge Manor continues to follow the guidelines set before us by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, the PA Department of Health and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services. We follow the most strict guidelines because we are caring for your loved ones.

We realize and understand that this pandemic seems endless. We feel much the same. While we are practicing all the Covid safety measures, we've tried to provide from the start, all the activities that used to be "normal" as best as we can. That means that we still provide the same types of activities we used to, we just do them a little differently.

Our group activities changed from big community-wide groups to smaller, unit-based groups. While still providing socialization, these groups were more intimate and cohesive. Friendships were made and strengthened.

As the pandemic changed, we did too and we're now gathering in larger, community groups. We continue that fun with a few cautionary actions.

On occasion, we have to isolate (code yellow) a particular unit as a precaution and in order to limit possible exposures. Our Activities Aides continue to conduct group activities on the isolated units with extra attention to the hand sanitizing and social distancing. We still have loads of fun!

The other (green) units join together for a meals, entertainment, bingo and other types of groups in our dining rooms and continue with their unit-based activities.
