#### New Visiting Guidelines!

We are happy to announce that our visitation guidelines now allow for more opportunities for you to visit with your family! This announcement was made in late March and beginning 3/31/2021 we welcomed family members & friends into our building.

If you've missed the guidelines, here are a few key points:

Hours: Mon./Wed./Fri./Sat./Sun. 10am-2pm Tues./Thurs. from 4 pm-7pm.

Masks are mandatory, 2 visitors at a time, must go to the resident room if it's a private room or to the visit area and back only if there's a roommate. You may *only* embrace if the resident has been vaccinated.

We suggest calling ahead preferably the day before to make sure there will be space available. We're not limiting visit time, but suggest perhaps an hour so that others will be able to receive visitors. Weather permitting you may visit in outside courtyards.

There is no change to the compassionate care visit process, and our guidelines are subject to change based on the changes made by CMS, the CDC, and our Pa DOH.

Please contact our Screener at extension 256 and ask for visit area availability. Our RN, Infection Preventionist is available at 207 to answer other questions you may have.
