Artists-in-Residence

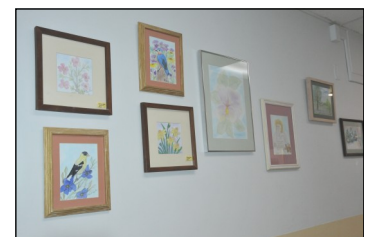

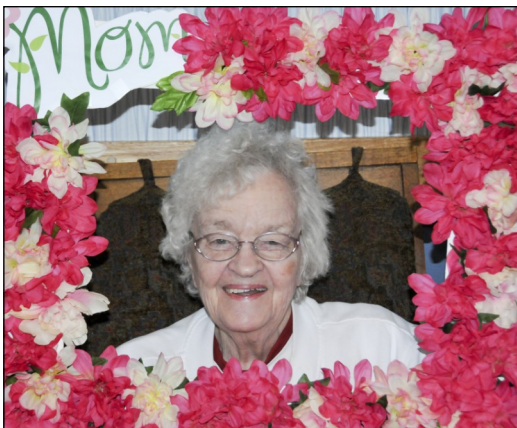

Covid –19 Facility Update

The Department of Health follows the CDC guidance on policies and we're continuing our steadfast efforts to keep everyone here safe and healthy by following both. In order to protect residents & staff, we need to continue limiting visitation, despite how challenging that is. The following limits will remain in place until we reach the Green phase per the Governor's guidance on reopening our Commonwealth.




- ◆ Family & friends living outside our facility are not able to visit.
- ◆ Visits are permitted for compassionate care situations such as end of life, clergy, bereavement counselors, etc. and should be allowed on a case-by-case basis with any questions. Consult with Stacey Schnars, RN; Infection Preventionist at (814)474-5521, ext. 207 with any questions.
- ◆ Everyone is screened prior to entering the facility; using the same protocols as staff screening, for a fever or any other symptoms of Covid-19. Anyone with any symptoms is not permitted in the facility. Compassionate care visitors are required to follow mitigation protocols such as practicing proper hand washing, wearing a mask or face covering at all times and limited access to the facility outside their loved one's room/location.
