#### Updated Visitation Guidelines

The holidays are fast arriving and we'll have many calls to ask about visiting loved ones. Here's our most recent guidance:

\*Small gatherings are permitted, with social distancing as space allows.

\*Large gatherings require reservation for designated spaces. \*Contact the Activities Department at (814) 474-5521, extensions 261/260.

\*Visitors are still required to complete screening prior to entry and will be required to wear a mask throughout the visit.

\*You may bring food and enjoy the food with your loved one while maintaining social distance.

\*Once finished, visitors are expected to reapply their masks for the remainder of the visit.

\*If visitation is with a resident currently in a "yellow" or "red" zone, visitation must be in their room.

\*If you visit more than one resident, on differing units, you must visit the resident in the "green" zone before going to a "yellow" or "red" zone. Thanks for your continuing
