Tip Of the Month:

We want to thank each of you for following the visitation guidelines we set forth at the beginning of our re-opening. Our priority is, and always has been, keeping our residents safe from the Covid-19 virus.

Here are just a couple of reminders for your visits here:

Masks are mandatory for visitors and staff for the duration of time one is in our building. Cloth masks are not acceptable.

Visitors are not permitted to eat or drink while with the resident they're visiting.

Our designated areas have not changed. Please remain in your visitation area while you're here; refrain from travelling throughout our building.

Our visiting hours are: Sun, Mon, Wed, Fri, and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Tues/Thurs from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Compassionate care visits may occur with Nursing Admin's guidance.

We continue testing our employees and volunteers as required and warranted. We will continue to follow the directives and guidance set forth by the CDC, CMS, and the Pa Department of Health.
